Milan Lucić, pianist (1985, Zenica, BiH). He graduated in 2007, and then received his master's degree in 2011, from the Piano Department at the Music Academy of the University of Sarajevo studying with prof. Svetlana Chlaidze. The third cycle of studies at the Music Academy of the University of Sarajevo ends in 2015, earning the title of Doctor of Musical Art. He is currently employed as a senior artistic associate at the Sarajevo Academy of Music. Important stages in the artistic career are master classes with eminent pianists and teachers J. Novotny, L. Pogorelic, G. Vidovic, E. Tawaststjerna, R. Gediga, D. Merlet. He attended a chamber music course with prof. Johannes and Edoard Kutrowatz (Baden, Austria). He received Karim Zaimović Foundation scholarship (2006), based on success in his studies and contributions to the cultural creativity of Sarajevo and Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as a scholarship for a prestigious master class at the L'Academie musicale de Villecroze, France. He is the recipient of the "Golden Badge" award of the University of Sarajevo, which is awarded to the best student of the University, as well as several awards at competitions, the most significant being the Special Award at the Federal Competition in Livno, BiH (2006), as well as the 3rd prize at the international competition Val Tidone, Italy (2007). He has performed at festivals "Sarajevska zima", "Bašćaršijske noći", "Dani Kantona Sarajevo", "Majske muzičke svečanosti", and has performed as a soloist with the Sarajevo Philharmonic Orchestra (2008). He has performed many concerts in BiH and abroad (Croatia, Serbia, Austria, Italy, Germany, France).
